Animal breeding restrictions

Animals cannot be bred under a Standard licence.

They can however be bred under a Specialised licence, but the number of vertebrates (reptiles, birds, and amphibians) cannot exceed 50 at any given time.

If you exceed your animal limit under a Standard or Specialised licence you must do one of the following:

- upgrade your licence
- seek approval to sell or give away excess animals
- euthanase them humanely.

There are no limits on breeding under an Advanced licence however, you will be limited to keeping a maximum of 50 dangerous snakes, unless you can demonstrate to the Chief Executive that you can reasonably and safely care for more.
